RIISING 5TH GRADE STUDENTS

Grade 5 -School Supplies for 2021-2022

Listed below are the supplies that your 5th grade child will need for the 2021-22 school year. Your child will be given information at the August "Meet and Greet" that will explain how to organize notebooks and supplies for the first day of school. **Consumable supplies (notebook paper, pens, pencils, erasers, etc.) will need to be replenished throughout the year.** Be sure to put your name and color on all notebooks and supplies before school begins.

General Supplies:

- 2 or 3 inch Binder – **REQUIRED**
- Zippered pencil case with holes to fit in notebook - sturdy
- 12 #2 pencils
- 2 red ballpoint pens– (not markers)
- 2 highlighter pens – one yellow and one blue
- 2 expo markers black or blue
- 6 poly dividers with pockets on both sides and write-on tabs one for each subject
- 1 individual sticky note pad (3x3)
- 1 package (200 count) of wide-ruled loose leaf paper
- Headphones or earbuds
- Insulated Water Bottle (labeled clearly with student's name)

Math

- Four (70 page) - 1 subject wide-ruled spiral notebooks - **red** (one labeled for each quarter)
- One composition notebook
- One 12- inch flexible ruler with cm and inches to be kept at home
- One 4" or 10 cm protractor (easy to read) to be kept at home
- One package of graph paper

ESW & Reading

- One (100+ page) - spiral notebook with vinyl cover- green
- One composition notebook (different color from math)

Science

- One (100+ page) - 1 subject wide-ruled spiral notebook- **blue**

Social Studies

- One pocket divider labeled social studies in binder for handouts and returned tests

Technology - iPads + Keyboard Case

All 5th Grade students will receive their school managed iPad and charger on the first day of school. For returning students, this is the same iPad that was assigned to them previously. The school will push all the required grade level apps to the iPads prior to the first day of school.

We require that students provide a protective case / keyboard for each iPad. The case/keyboard combos we highly recommend are made by either Logitech or Zagg. We recommend selecting one of their more rugged cases to endure the daily handling and transport of the iPad. For returning students, you may continue to use the same case/keyboard as last year. If the old one is no longer in optimal conditions, you may consider providing a new one. You will receive more communication regarding this and the iPad model prior to the start of the school year.

***Backpacks are optional. If your child does decide to use a backpack, please remember it must fit easily inside the lockers which are 15" x 15", and it should not have wheels.*
